

The BIOSENTRY TRACT SEALANT SYSTEM is indicated for sealing pleural punctures to significantly reduce the risk of pneumothoraces (air leaks) associated with percutaneous, transthoracic needle lung biopsies and to provide accuracy in marking a biopsy location for visualization during surgical resection. BIOSENTRY TRACT SEALANT SYSTEM is used during computed tomography guided core needle biopsy. The BIOSENTRY TRACT SEALANT SYSTEM deploys a self-expanding hydrogel plug into the pleural space following a percutaneous lung biopsy. This creates an airtight seal that closes the pleural puncture. Additionally, the hydrogel plug accurately marks the biopsy location for visualization during surgical resection.

This instrument should only be used by a physician familiar with the possible side effects, typical findings, limitations, and contraindications of lung biopsies. Physician judgment is required when considering biopsy on patients with bleeding disorders, receiving anticoagulant medications, or with bullous emphysema at or near the biopsy site.
