INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The Merit Medical Rad Rest[®] is an adjustable stabilization and positioning cushion used to hyperextend the wrist for radial access and support the forearm/elbow during procedures. Product not made with natural rubber latex (Figure 1).

INDICATIONS FOR USE

The Rad Rest is intended to be used as an adjustable upper extremity stabilization and positioning cushion when used with the Rad Board $^\circ$ or Rad Board Xtra $^\infty$.

- Designed to elevate the patient arm to working level, without the need for additional padding

POTENTIAL COMPLICATIONS NONE KNOWN

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- 1. Place the Rad Rest on a stable platform for upper extremity access procedures in the arm. The Merit Medical Rad Board[®] (sold separately) is recommended.


NOTE: The Rad Rest is non-sterile. If used in sterile field, drape as necessary.


- 2. Adjust the Rad Rest to fit the length of the forearm by pulling the elbow end of the Rad Rest back. Rest elbow on cushion.
- Position the patient's forearm with the palm-side of the hand up on the Rad Rest. Tape the patient's fingers lightly to the hand end of the Rad Rest to hyperextend the wrist and secure the hand to the Rad Rest (Figure 2).
- 4. Continue with standard procedure and patient preparation.

NOTE: The Rad Rest is non-sterile. If used in sterile field, drape as necessary.

- 5. The Rad Rest is absorbent and will help to contain fluids and reduce floor runoff.
- 6. Dispose of Rad Rest after the procedure.
